Great Oaks has received food waste bins, and Southampton residents will soon be getting them too. The aim is to reduce landfill waste and help people think more carefully about what they throw away.

The Gazette team feels food waste bins are a good idea, as long as they are maintained properly to prevent pests and unpleasant smells.

Food waste bins can be used for kitchen scraps, leftovers, peelings, expired food, eggshells, tea bags (without plastic), coffee grounds, fruit, bread, rice and pasta. Items such as cooking oil, pet waste, garden waste, tin foil and nappies should not be included.

If used correctly, food waste bins can have a positive impact on the environment.

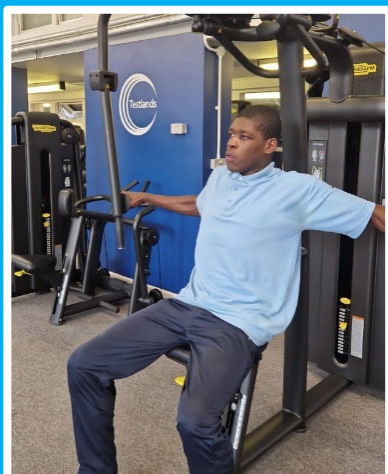

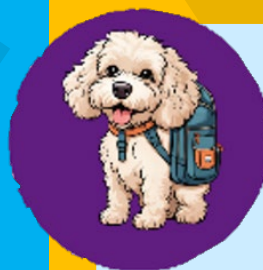
South Site News
