Important information about Road Closure

We have been informed that upcoming Southern Water works are due to take place along Winchester Road at the Hollybrook roundabout and on its junction with Wilton Road.

These works are planned to start from Saturday 10 May 2025 and are expected to take approximately 3 weeks to complete.

At the roundabout, the northbound lane of Winchester Road will be closed to traffic from $10^{th}-18^{th}$ May, with a diversion route in operation via Burgess Road and Bassett Avenue. This means that access to Vermont Close will only be from the North end of the Winchester Road.

We have made transport aware but there is inevitably going to be some delay to traffic coming from and going to school.

We have also been informed that there is a slight chance of some disruption to water supply during this time but at least 48hrs notice will be given. We will let you know if there are any implications for school as soon as we are able.
