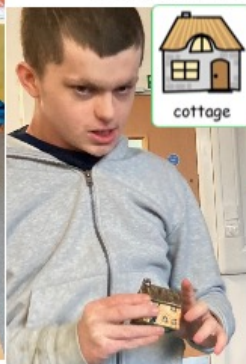

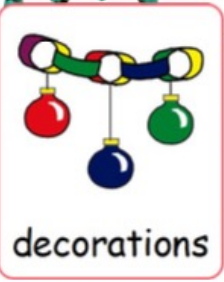
? i do you need to plan an activity for a group of strangers?
